Dear Ms. Pintar:

As you know, the Pebble Beach Community Services District (PBCSD) initiated condemnation proceedings to acquire an approximately two acre portion of Land Use Area I-1 (APN 008-031-017) owned by Pebble Beach Company (the "Company"). As a result of these condemnation proceedings, PBCSD and the Company have entered into an agreement pursuant to which PBCSD will purchase the two acres in question along with a small amount of our entitlement water. PBCSD intends to use the land and the entitlement water to build certain publicly owned and operated improvements to its existing fire safety and sanitary operations. These public improvements will be built on both the property being acquired from the Company and on PBCSD's existing and immediately adjacent property (APN 008-031-009).

For these reasons, and as we discussed on January 10, 2003, the Company supports PBCSD's request to approve a technical amendment to the Fiscal Sponsorship Agreement between the Company and the Water Management District dated August 1, 1990. The proposed technical amendment would allow up to one acre foot of the Company's entitlement water that is currently dedicated to Land Use Planning Area I-1 to be transferred to the immediately adjacent property that is owned and operated by PBCSD on behalf of the residents of the Del Monte Forest.
