Subject: Sentinel Well Data Collection Program – Proposal for Hydrogeologic Services

Dear Joe:

Following up on our discussions, I'm pleased to provide this proposal to assist the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District (District) with data collection from the recently installed Sentinel Wells. Presented in this proposal is a outline of the data collection plan and an estimate of associated costs.

As you are aware the adopted data collection program for Sentinel Well data collection program tentatively includes quarterly induction logging and continuous water level data collection. This basis program was to be supplemented with the periodic collection of depth-specific downhole water quality sampling.

Based on this framework I have developed a data collection program that meets the overall framework provides required data and minimizes annual costs. The components of this program are as follows:

Data collection from each well:

- Quarterly down-loading of water level data logger
- Quarterly induction logging
- Annual Depth-Specific at two depths
- Water quality analysis (general mineral) of collected water quality samples

Quarterly Reporting:

- Induction log overlays and analysis
- Water level hydrographs

Annual costs for the data collection program are estimated at \$26,800 inclusive of outside services. A breakdown of costs is presented in the attached table.
