Dear Sir or Madam:

As a property owner with a water well located within 1,000/300 feet of a well(s) located on the parcel(s) referenced above, this notice is written to inform you that the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District (MPWMD or District) staff has determined that the Application to create or amend a Water Distribution System (WDS) on the above-referenced parcel has been determined to be **complete/incomplete**. [*pick one*]

A complete application typically means that the District has adequate documentation to prepare permit documents for the well(s) in question, and that the applicant has provided adequate information on well reliability, lack of impact to neighboring wells such as yours, and lack of impact to specified water resources. An incomplete application means that additional information is needed before a permit decision is made.

You have the right to appeal this determination to the MPWMD Board within 21 days (see "Date of Complete/Incomplete Determination" above) pursuant to MPWMD Rule 70, and based on proper evidence. Rule 70 is provided on the MPWMD website at:
