As a property owner with a water well located within 1,000/300 feet of a well(s) located on the parcel(s) referenced above, this notice is written to inform you that the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District (MPWMD or District) staff has determined that the Application to create or amend a Water Distribution System (WDS) on the above-referenced parcel should be approved subject to at least 26 Conditions of Approval.

Permit authorization means that the District has determined, based on documentation and evidence in the record, that the requirements of MPWMD Rule 22 have been met. Simply stated, the applicant has demonstrated adequate well reliability to meet his/her needs, that there would not be adverse effects to neighboring wells such as yours, and there would not be adverse effects to specified water resources.
