The MPWMD Board of Directors is scheduled to consider the first reading of Ordinance No. 134 at its May 19, 2008 meeting. MPWMD staff would like to share information about Ordinance No. 134 and answer questions from residents of the Laguna Seca area (California American Water customers of the Bishop, Hidden Hills and Ryan Ranch systems).

Proposed Ordinance No. 134 would amend the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District Rules and Regulations to amend the definition of the Monterey Peninsula Water Resource System (MPWRS) to include the Northern Inland Subarea and the Southern Inland Subarea, i.e., Laguna Seca Subarea, of the Seaside Groundwater Basin. Amending the definition of the MPWRS is necessary to respond to present and threatened water emergencies caused when increased consumption would force production above the legal limits set by the Seaside Basin Adjudication decision.

Proposed Ordinance No. 134 would also amend District Regulation XV, the District's *Expanded Water Conservation and Standby Rationing Plan*. Specifically, as a result of amending the definition of the MPWRS, all water distribution systems, private wells, or water users who derive their source of supply from the Laguna Seca Subarea could be subject to the District's water conservation and rationing regulations.

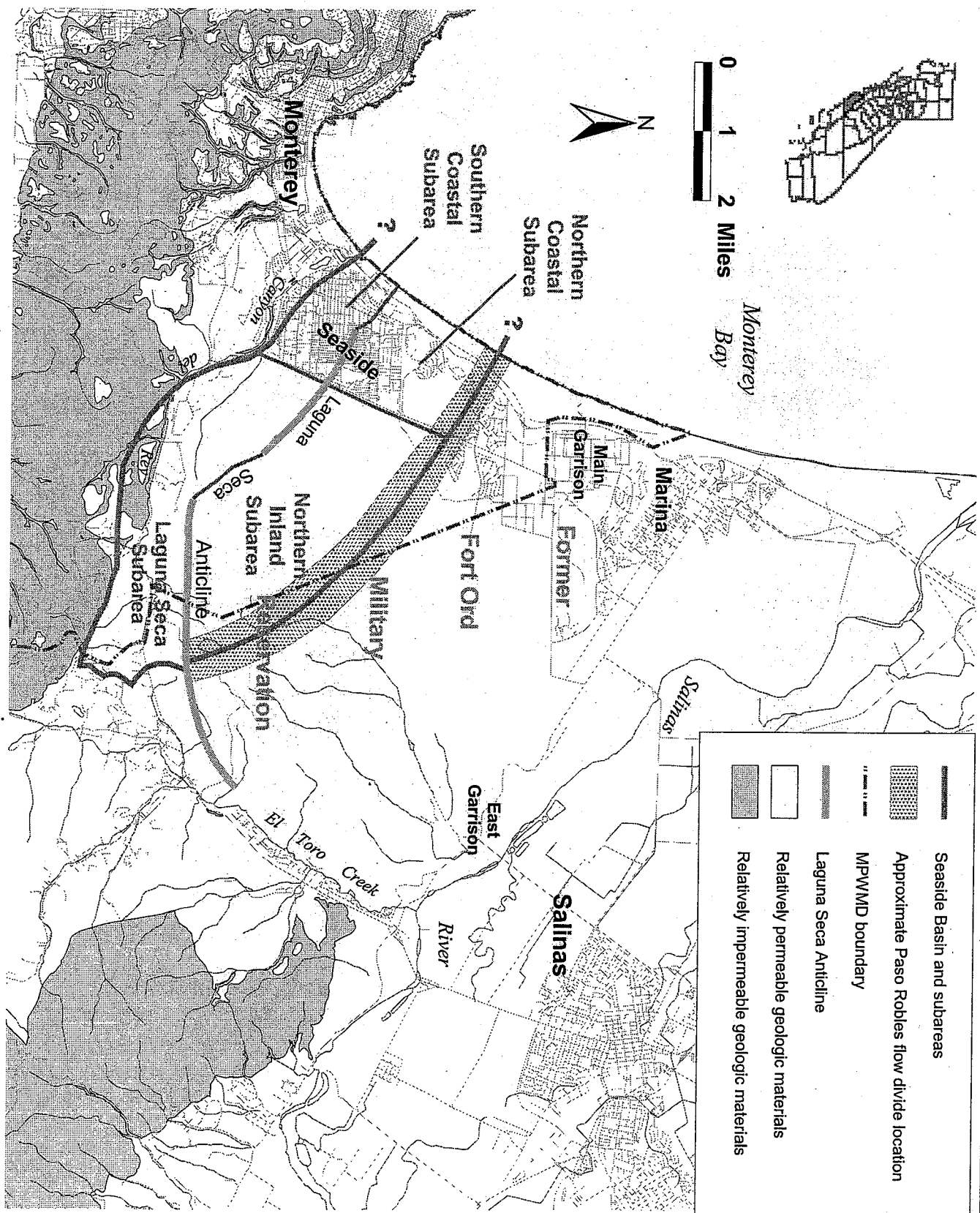


Figure 1. Location of the Seaside Groundwater Basin
