CONSERVATION OPPORTUNITIES

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- Drought tolerant plant tags
- Green-certified landscapes
- Buy backs – fixtures, turf, etc.
- Cash for Grass
- Annex remote connections – currently outside MPWMD/CAW purview
- Support/promote Gray water systems
- Jurisdictional support for programs
- Support conservation based rates
- Jurisdiction acceptance of zero water consumption urinals
- Public retrofit assistance
- Drought tolerant plant promotions
- Pool cover rebate
- Support local green programs
- Sponsor/grant for David Ave reservoir retrofit/refurbishing
- Free install of rain sensors and/or soil moisture sensors on audits
- Grants for Smart controller subscriptions
- Set up traveling conservation demonstration trailer with working displays
- CAW system audit
- Auditor and green gardener certification programs
- CII grants/loans
- Prioritize uses during rationing
- Allow suspension of water banks by Board Resolution
- Transfer credit only for actual uses that occurred in past 10 years. (Rule 28B)
- Split meters for master metered accounts (Gentry Hill, Sleepy Hollow, Hitchcock Cyn, etc.)
- Waterbroom, ice machines, cooling tower rebates
- Co-fund stormwater reuse projects
- Provide financial incentives for synthetic turf
- Sponsor recycled water project (300 AF)
- Inspect CII requirements
- Update commercial water factors
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POSSIBLE CONSERVATION REQUIREMENTS

- Separate metering requirement for fire service
- Separate metering requirement for outdoor use
- Retrofit requirements for mobile homes
- Recirculating or instant-access hot water throughout homes for remodels

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- Sub-metering guidelines
- Gray water/cisterns policy - County regulations, need guidelines
- Dual plumbing (purple pipe) all new construction
- Disallow once-through condenser cooling. Air cooled or closed loop only. Establish retrofit date.
- Cooling tower retrofits. Establish efficiency standards. Establish retrofit date
- Establish an individual meter water pressure standard
- Establish baseline exterior water use standards
 - Smart controllers
 - Limit landscaping
- Cisterns for individual use (not trucked in)
- Ban overhead sprinklers
- Develop subpotable supplies to replace potable (w/truck delivery)
- Sponsor training on green landscapes
- Adopt restrictions on dual services (i.e. both CAW and other serving one property)
- Complete FREE retrofits to low income properties
- Sponsor and/or require pre-rinse spray valve retrofits
- Commercial laundry retrofit program
- Disallow water credits in Stage 5
- Institute mandatory cutbacks on large water users
- Zero water consumption urinals
- Require negative demand for new construction/expansions in use
- Pool covers
- Towel/linen reuse requirement
- No salt water softeners
- Multi-stream rotor sprinkler retrofit program (Elsinore Valley Muni Water District)
- Ban hand car washing at Stage 4
