A Water Use Credit documented prior to the CDO will be reinstated with the same value and term as existed on the date of the CDO. A Water Use Credit documented after the CDO will be reinstated with the initial term allowed by Rule 25.5. In the event that any portion of a Water Use Credit is used prior to the reinstatement date, the amount of the reinstated Water Use Credit will be reduced to reflect the remaining amount

This is to advise that, on **September 17, 2012**, the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District (the lead agency) approved the above-described ordinance. On September 17, 2012, the District Board made the following determinations, based on a circulated Initial Study/Proposed Negative Declaration:

- 1. The project *will not* have a significant effect on the environment.
