Consider First Reading of Ordinance No. 170 – Amending Rules 11, 20, 21, 22, 24, 25.5, AND 142

Ord No. 170 – 2015 California Code Updates

- Executive Order B-29-15 (April 1, 2015)
- Directed DWR to revise the Model Water Efficient Landscape Ordinance
 - New landscaped areas of 500 sf
 - Renovated landscaped areas over 2,500 sf
 - Water Permit required in coordination with Jurisdictions
- California Energy Commission adopted emergency regulations establishing standards to improve the efficiency of water appliances
 - Reduced faucet flow rates and urinal standards

Ordinance No. 170 – Other Actions

- Exempts from Water Permit requirement: Replacement of a large (documented) tub with a standard tub or stall shower
- Exempts rainwater capture facilities from Water Distribution System Permit requirement
- Recognizes that new connections may occur in Cal-Am in certain instances (e.g. Malpaso and Sand City)

Ordinance No. 170 – Section 7 Amendment

Amend Section 7 as shown:

h. Permit shall identify whether interties to other systems are allowed and shall identify restrictions or prohibitions on such interties, including devices to prevent cross-contamination of systems. MPWMD shall not approve any Water Permit for new Connections to the California American Water system, based on California American Water's authorized water *rights*, due to the inability of a permitted *Non-California American Water* Water Distribution System to deliver adequate water quality or quantity to Parcels within its Service Area until there is full compliance by California American Water with State Water Resources Control Board Order No. WR 95-10 (as amended); California American Water compliance with the March 2006 Final Decision of the Seaside Groundwater Basin Adjudication (as amended); and water is available in the respective Jurisdiction's Allocation for release to the Parcels(s);
