Conservation Outreach

- Provided water efficiency information at the Monterey County Business Council's Green Building Expo and at the Monterey Peninsula Chamber of Commerce's Business Expo, also at the Conference Center;
- Distributed local water curriculum workbooks to local schools;
- Continued to work with Monterey Peninsula Unified School District to implement conservation retrofits;



TURN IT OFF

- Sprinkler systems can usually be shut off between now and April
 - Water by hand and only when plants are visibly thirsty
 - Take advantage of wetter/cooler months to upgrade your irrigation system
- Overwatering causes root rot and does not help the health of the plant
- Don't let your irrigation system waste your water



Water Winners

Now is the time to install:

- A rainwater harvesting system
- A graywater irrigation system
- Stormwater catchment basins
