- August Draft a comprehendible one-page legislative fact sheet outlining the current problem, background and legislative solution.
- September beginning of December Meet with community interests and begin discussions and negotiations on the proposed legislation. During this time, I would advise that a district representative from Assemblymember Stone's office attend a few of these meetings, or, at the very least, receive regular updates. Furthermore, MPWMD should reach out to legislative delegation and provide background and intent of the legislation.
- **December** Ideally, a compromise is reached and MPWMD is ready to move forward with legislation. Revise fact sheet and language and meet with Assemblymember Stone for final confirmation of him authoring the bill.
- January Final language should be complete and submitted to Legislative Counsel.
- **February** JEA & Associates should begin having conversations with Assembly Water, Parks & Wildlife Committee when bill is referred to committee for hearing.
- May MPWMD and JEA & Associates should begin conversations with the Administration, more specifically, the State Water Resources Board and Resources Agency.
