1. Receive Minutes of January 9, 2007 and January 31, 2008 Committee Meetings

On a motion by Pendergrass and second by Mancini, the minutes were received unanimously on a vote of 11 to 0.

2. Develop Recommendation to the Board Regarding First Reading of Ordinance No. 137 – Amending Regulation XV, Expanded Water Conservation and Standby Rationing Plan

Mancini offered a motion that was seconded by Cort, to recommend that the Board of Directors adopt the first reading of draft Ordinance No. 137. The motion was approved unanimously on a vote of 11 to 0. During discussion of this item, staff responded to questions from the committee and members of the public. During the public comment period on this item, Lloyd Lowrey, representing property owners in Hidden Hills, requested that the District conduct extensive public outreach on this ordinance prior to adoption. He expressed concern about five issues, including proposed triggers that prompt the onset of upper stages of the conservation program, and how the issue of unaccounted for water is dealt with.
