How to use these tables to estimate your winter water allotment.

Your winter water allotment is determined by the number of persons in your home and any livestock you may have. The example above shows a family of three with no livestock. This household is allotted 45 units of water per month, per tier. For their first 45 units, they are charged at the rate of \$0.28 per unit; the next 45 units at \$0.40, etc. (see rate tier chart on the right). This rate program encourages conservation and discourages water waste.

Other examples (with different allotments and usage):

If this household is **allotted 30 units per tier**, and **uses 70 units per month...**

On July 9, 2009, The California Public Utilities Commission authorized new rates for water service in California American Water's Monterey District. Beginning in tier 3 and up, they are allotted 55 units of water.
