**MONTEREY PENINSULA WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT
RULE 24**

**E. ADJUSTMENT OF CALCULATIONS WHERE SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES
EXIST**

1. The General Manager may reduce (or increase) the Adjusted Water Use Capacity when Special Circumstances exist with respect to the anticipated water consumption ~~resulting from that Permit~~. Special Circumstances shall be deemed to exist in the following circumstances:
 - a. Prior to or Aafter project completion and after verification that a Sub-potable Water source (e.g., from a cistern type system) or untreated Well water is ~~will be~~ the exclusive supply for all exterior uses, the General Manager may make a proportional adjustment for the final Adjusted Water Use Capacity and shall refund that portion of the Connection Charge and the portion of water debited from an Allocation or Water Entitlement.
