The DDA contract for \$468,763 completes the CEQA process from the existing contract (provides first administrative draft EIR sections) through the next rounds of administrative draft EIR, the DEIR, responding to comments, the FEIR, and the certification process (scope of work attached).
 - The Engineering Report contract (an essential part of the CDPH approval process) will be brought to the RWC and Board in July or August.
 - Additionally, there will be a few new contracts for some of the technical consultants to respond to the DEIR comments that will be initiated when the comments are received.

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> There are several existing contracts that must be honored to complete the CEQA DEIR technical support (to be completed in August) including the Feasibility Study/Facilities Plan work (to be completed in October), and the 10% designs (to be completed in July).

Budget B is the Public Outreach/Demonstration Budget.

A public outreach plan will be developed as soon as the water rights negotiations have been finalized. The plan implementation would probably start with the release of the Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) this summer. A major part of the Plan is the pilot demonstration facilities as they are a great vehicle for informing the public of how safe and pure the water will be. Staff has been approached by the Santa Cruz and Soquel Creek Water Districts to rent the pilot facilities for their CEQA testing purposes. Also, if not purchased now, pilot facilities would be purchased as part of the GWR construction contract to allow a facility to try out different membranes and chemicals.
