A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE MONTEREY PENINSULA WATER MANAGEMENT DISTRICT TO AUTHORIZE THE GENERAL MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE CALIFORNIA STATE COASTAL CONSERVANCY FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES TO CARRY OUT CONSTRUCTION OF THE SLEEPY HOLLOW STEELHEAD REARING FACILITY UPGRADE

Resolved by the Board of Directors of the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District to obtain reimbursement of expenses from the California State Coastal Conservancy for construction to upgrade the Sleepy Hollow Steelhead Rearing Facility (Project). The Project will be constructed to enhance and protect the anadromous salmonid fishery in the Carmel River. The General Manager of the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District is hereby authorized and directed to enter into an agreement to receive funds for such a Project with the California State Coastal Conservancy.
