# New 2016 Conservation/Rationing Plan

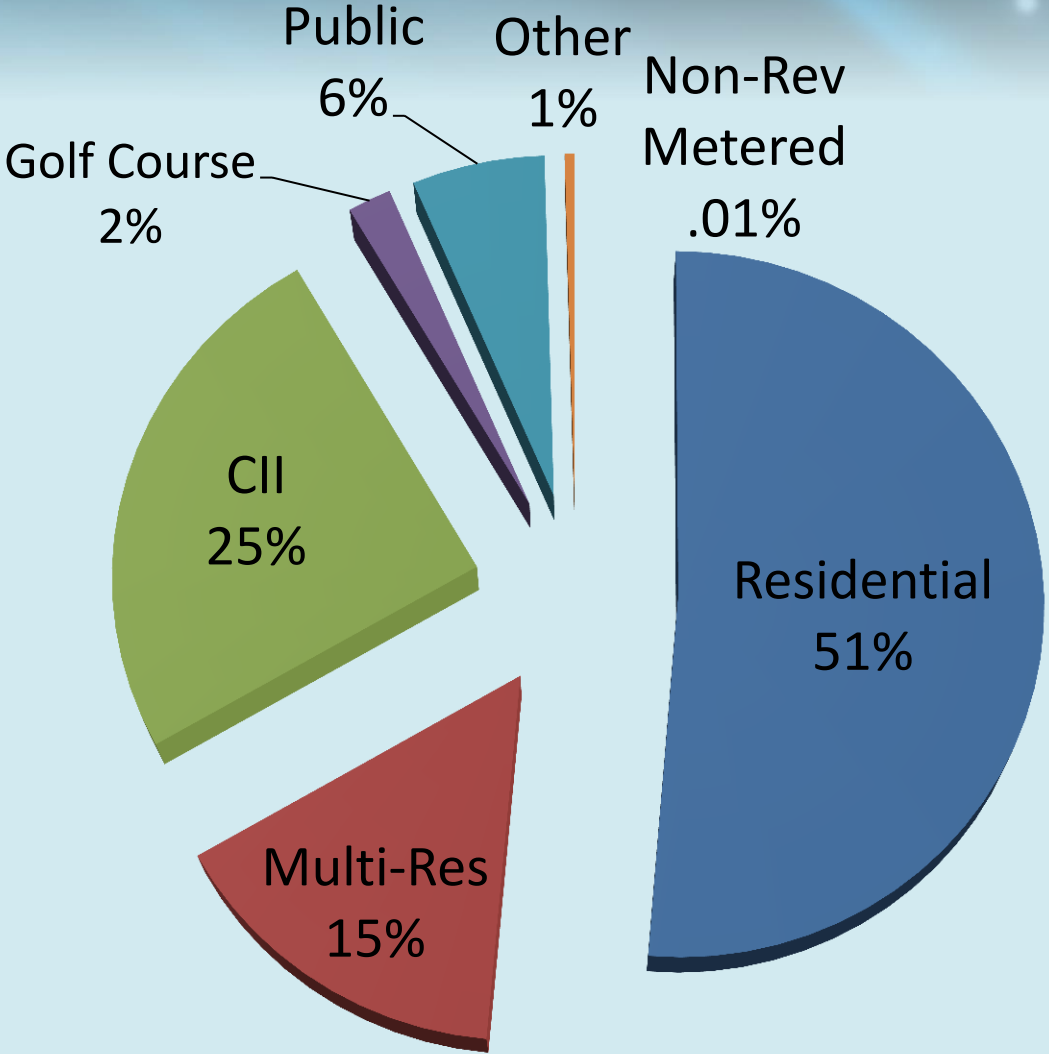
- 4 Stages to respond to:

  - Regulatory (missed production targets)
  - Regulatory order
  - Emergency

Contains definition of water waste, enforcement process, and water waste fines	Call for action and increased water waste enforcement and outreach	25% Level 1 surcharge	Residential and non-essential commercial rationing first
		40% Level 2 surcharge	Moratorium

# New 2016 Conservation/Rationing Plan

- “Hardship” variances available (large families, medical needs, etc.)
- Best Management Practice-compliant commercial use variance
- No variances for:
  - Guests and short-term visitors
  - Irrigation
  - Filling pools, spas, ponds, fountains, etc.
  - Leaks that are not repaired promptly

# Public and Committee Review

- Recommended by Water Demand Committee
- Supported by California American Water
- Two Public Workshops
- Cal-Am Public Workshop
  - Part of the current rate proceeding (A.15-07-019)
- 2 Public Hearings

# Recommendation

- 2 edits for second reading:
  - Board packet pg. 113: Amend E-3 (Sunset) to delete unnecessary language “...and conditions 163-E-1 and 163-E-2 have been met.”
  - Pg. 119, section E-1, second paragraph typo “responsibility” (2<sup>nd</sup> line)
- Receive public comment
- Approve second reading and adoption of Ordinance No. 169
