









How Did LAFCO Go?

After Dec 6th LAFCO Hearing – 6 Pronged Approach

 Outreach to LAFCO Commissioners • 3 Commissioners Contacted; Votes Unchanged Seek Reconsideration • LAFCO Denied Reconsideration February 28th Wait for Change in LAFCO Make-Up / Re-Apply Gourley & Leffel Reappointed; Craig up in 2023 Litigation • In progress; Fairly High Standard Special Legislation • Have Language; Hampered by No Author Proceed Anyway • District's Power to Sell Preceded LAFCO Authority
