

NOTICE INVITING SEALED BIDS

MONITORING WELL FO-09 SHALLOW DESTRUCTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that sealed bids will be received by the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District (MPWMD) at 5 Harris Court, Building G, Monterey, California, 93940 until 2:00 pm August 11, 2021, at which time they shall be publicly opened and read. The Contractor shall furnish all labor, materials, supplies, equipment, and services required to perform the work, except as expressly stated in the Special Conditions, necessary to:

1. Acquire destruction permit from Monterey County Environmental Health Bureau (MCEHB). The destruction plan outlined in this document has already been approved by this agency.
2. Mobilize equipment, containment tankage, etc. to the site.
3. Fish abandoned ¾-inch PVC pipe from both wells in the dual completion.
4. Insert tremie pipe or tubing to bottom of FO-9S.
5. Pump MCEHB-approved sealing material to fill the well (estimated volume of sealing material ~0.5 yard). Retain displaced water in suitable tankage (Estimated volume 900 gallons).
6. Remove tremie pipe. Top off casing to surface.
7. Clean up site. Dispose of ¾-inch PVC. Remove displaced water from site.

Site is located at 181 Okinawa Rd, Seaside, CA 93955. Time is of the essence in the conduct of this project.

The work shall be done in accordance with the Specifications therefore adopted, to which special reference is hereby made. Pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 3400, if MPWMD has made any findings designating certain materials, products, things, or services by specific brand or trade name, such findings and the materials, products, things, or services and their specific brand or trade names will be set forth in the Special Conditions.

Contractor shall hold a valid Class C-57 Contractors License issued by the State of California. Bids shall be accompanied by U.S. currency, certified check, cashier's check, or bid bond in an amount not less than ten percent (10%) of the bid amount, and shall be made payable to the Monterey Peninsula Water Management District.

The project requires payment of the general prevailing rate of per diem wages (Labor Code 1770, et seq.) and is subject to compliance monitoring and enforcement by the Department of Industrial Relations (DIR). No contractor or subcontractor may be listed on a bid proposal for, nor awarded a contract for work on, a public works project unless registered with the DIR pursuant to Labor Code Section 1725.5. The prime contractor shall post job site notices, as prescribed by regulation. Each contractor and subcontractor shall furnish the records specified in Labor Code Section 1776 directly to the Labor Commissioner, in the manner prescribed under Section 1771.4.

MPWMD shall award the contract for the Project to the responsible Bidder with the lowest responsive bid as determined by MPWMD. MPWMD reserves the right to reject any and all bids or to waive any irregularities or informalities in any bid or in the bidding. The bid shall remain valid for 90 days after the bid opening date.
