



HYDRANT METER PERMIT APPLICATION (A.K.A. CONSTRUCTION METER)

A Mobile Water Distribution System (i.e. water moved by a truck or water used from an offsite hydrant) requires a Hydrant Meter Permit from the District. Delivery or receipt of water from an unpermitted Mobile Water Distribution System is considered Water Waste and subject to fines and cease and desist orders. California American Water will not provide portable water meters unless a Hydrant Meter Permit from the District has been received. A Hydrant Meter Permit shall specify an expiration date of 60 days from date of issuance. A fee of \$125 is required for issuance of initial permit. It may be extended twice by submitting a new application requesting additional time requirements. Completing the Hydrant Meter Permit Application does not guarantee issuance of a Permit. (*Rules 22, 23, 25*).
