



The Monterey Peninsula Water Management District (MPWMD) is responsible for regional water resource management on the Monterey Peninsula and Carmel Valley. The District's mission is to promote or provide for a long-term sustainable water supply, and to manage and protect water resources for the benefit of the community and the environment.



MPWMD is seeking energetic and enthusiastic individuals to assist in various fisheries and aquatic resources programs on the Carmel River, Monterey County.

Water Resources Assistant - \$14.75 per hour (seasonal, part-time)

The Water Resources Assistant will assist in such duties as:

- performance of seasonal fish rescues
- operation of a Fyke trap
- collection of ecological and physical data regarding the Carmel River
- operation and maintenance of the steelhead rearing facility
- maintenance of field equipment used in the fisheries program
- assist staff in groundwater and surface water quality monitoring, and vegetation monitoring around the Carmel River Lagoon

Education and Experience:

College-level course work in environmental science, biology, ecology, forestry, the physical sciences, or a related field, and some experience in field biology, data collection and reporting are desired.

Hours and Availability:

Candidate must be available to begin by June 1, 2017 but start date may be delayed based on river conditions. The latest start date would be July 1, 2017 and will last until end of October 2017. Candidates must be available for approximately 32 hours per week and up to 40 hours, including weekends.

Working and Physical Conditions:

Field environment; work in and around water; exposure to electricity and inclement weather conditions. Essential functions of the job require maintaining physical condition necessary for moderate to heavy lifting and carrying; standing and walking for prolonged periods.

License or Certificate: Possession of, or ability to obtain, an appropriate, valid California drivers license.
