Hi Matthew,

This is a brief message to provide a status update on the Seaside Basin ASR project. Normally at this time of the year we would be finishing up preparation of a technical report to provide to your office that summarizes operations during the preceding year, in this case WY 2014. However, WY 2014 was a critically-dry year with no Carmel River flows available above minimum bypass flow requirements during the winter diversion season. Accordingly, no ASR operations occurred in WY 2014 and therefore a summary of operations report has not been prepared for that year.

Even though there is no summary report for WY 2014, the ASR project was operated in WY 2015 and we will be preparing a summary report for this year. In that report, we intend to include data from the network of ASR water-level monitoring wells that will span both WY 2014 and 2015. We are planning to have the WY 2015 summary report to your office as much as possible before the July 1, 2016 due date.
