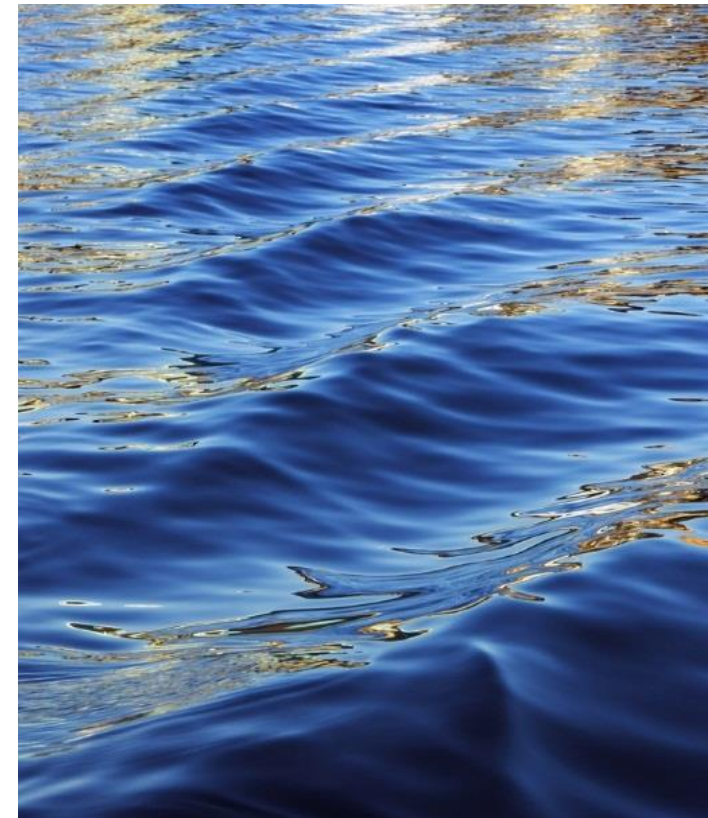

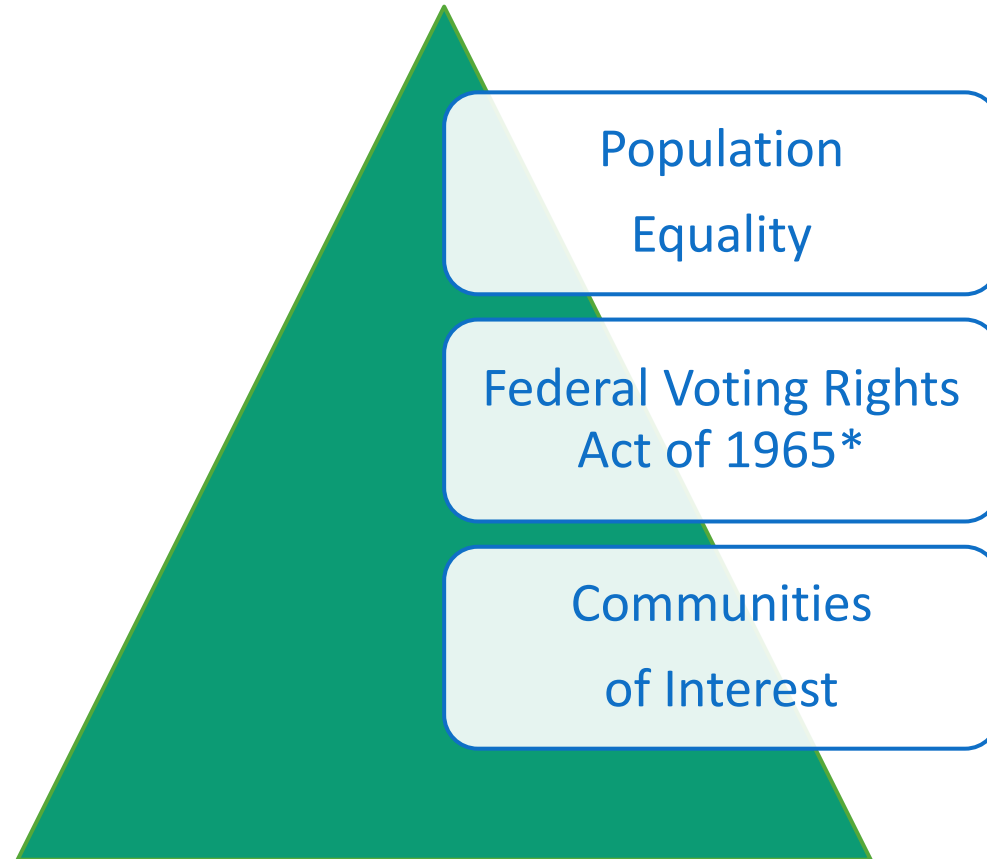

What is Redistricting?

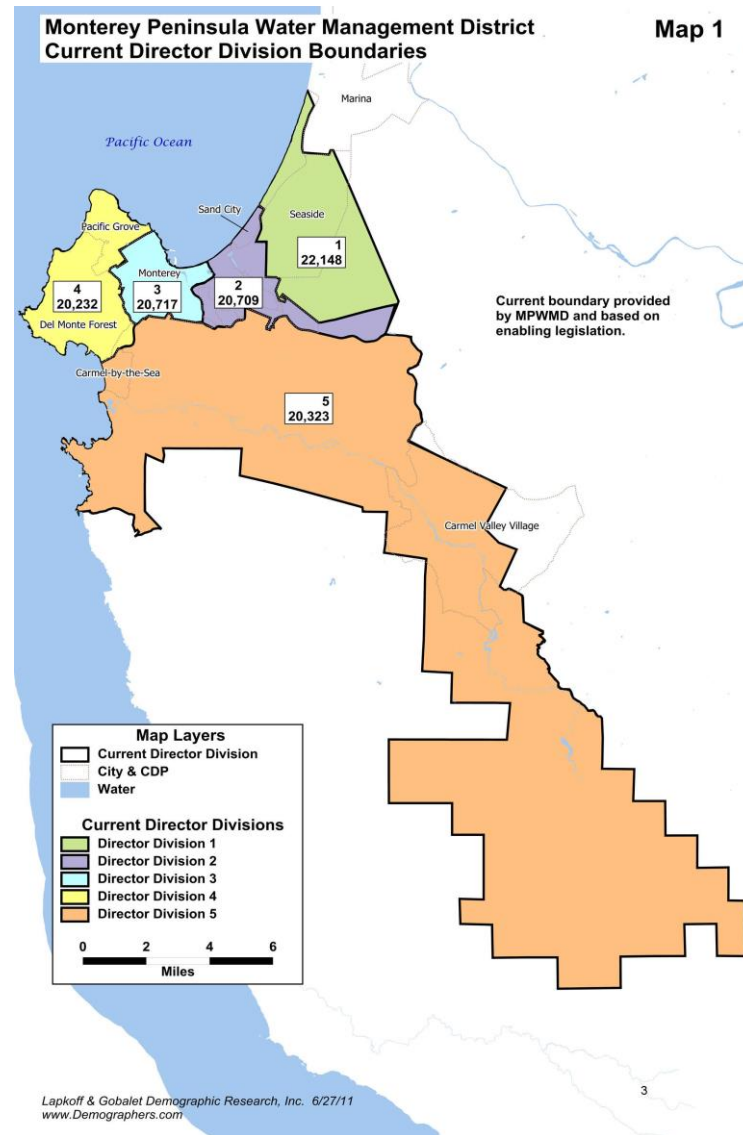
- Applies to all jurisdictions that elect members by district or division
- Based on revised Census data every 10 years
- Seeks to balance populations in each voter division

Legal Requirements

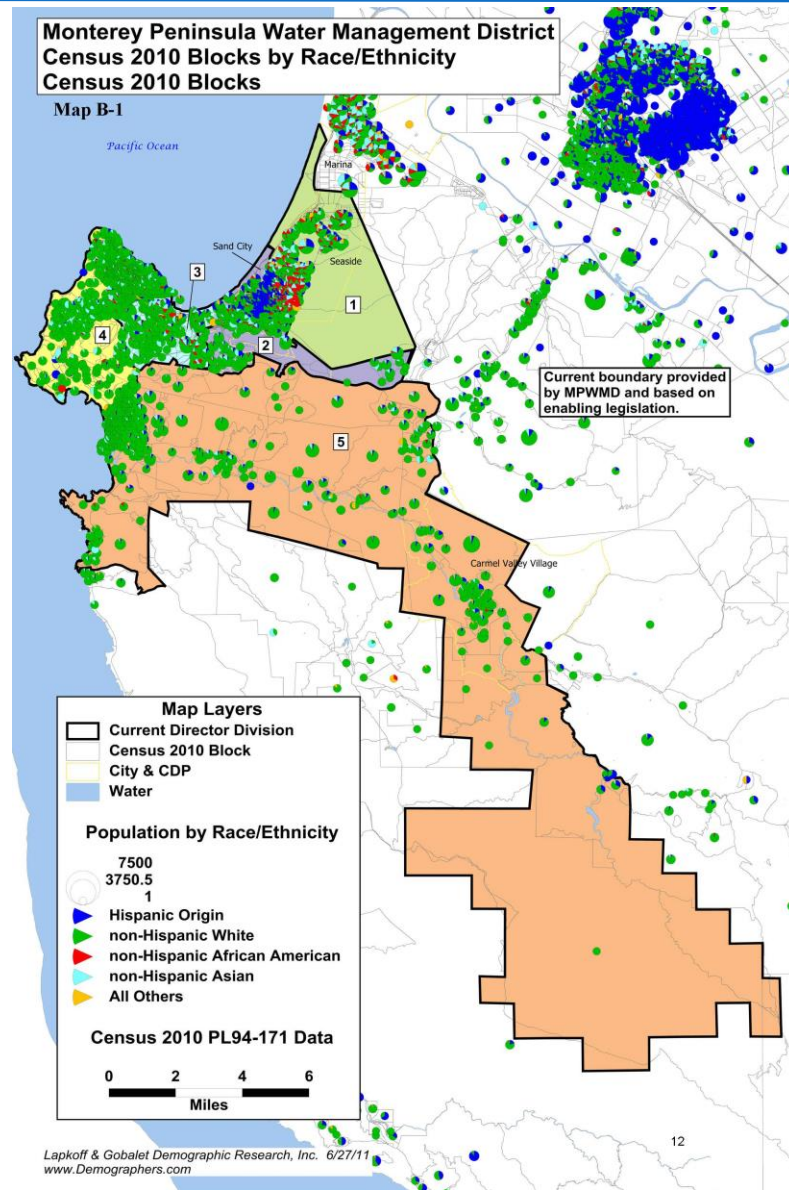

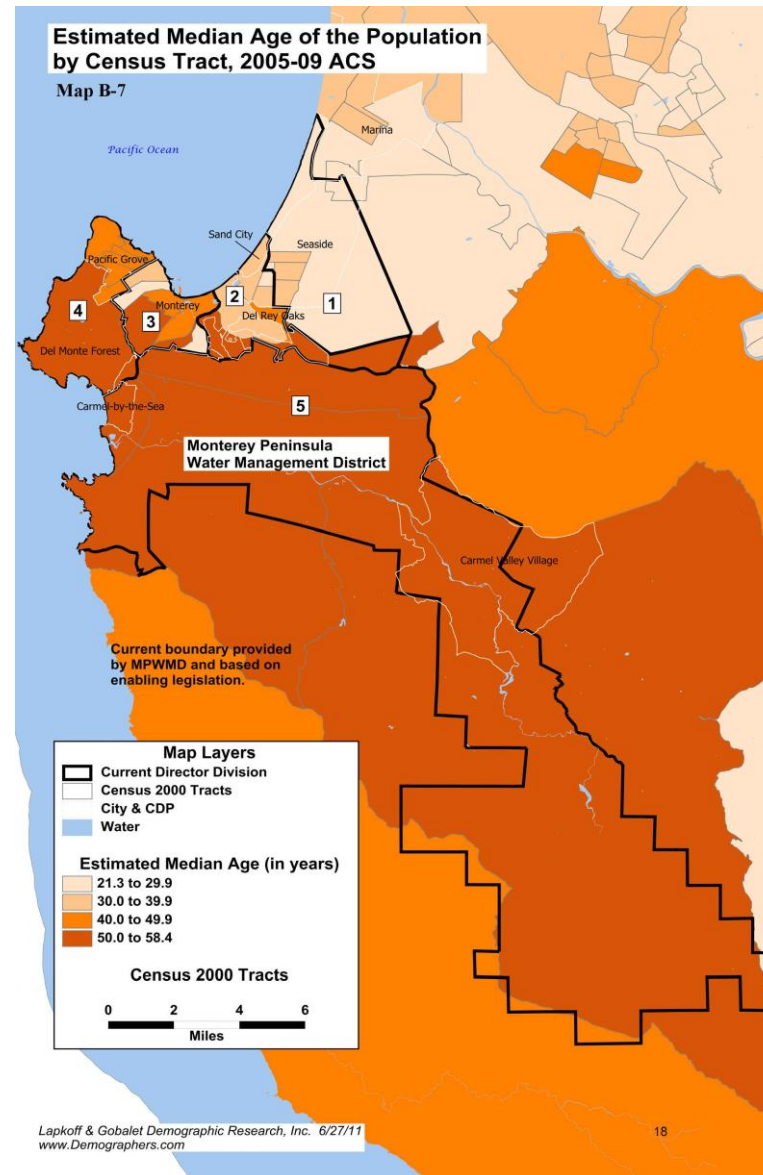
Existing Divisions (2010 Census)



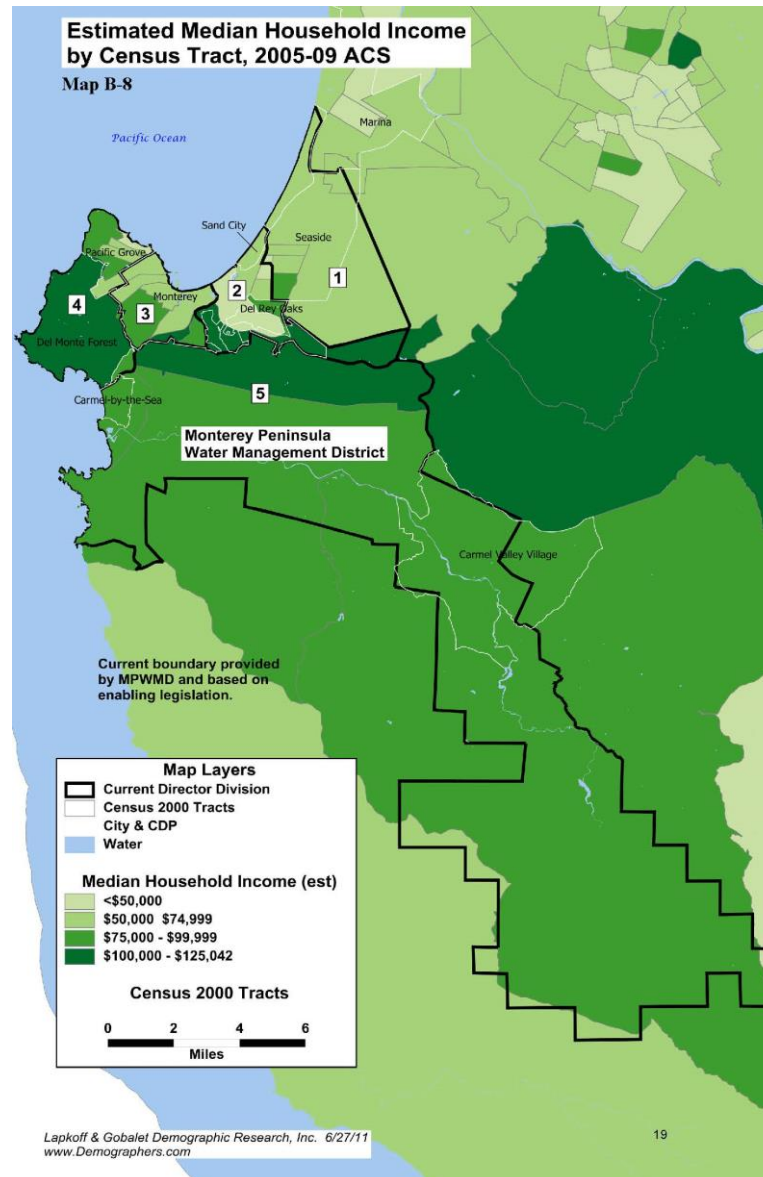
Example: Ethnicity

The District has contracted with Lapkoff & Gobalet Demographic Research, Inc.



	Item
Ongoing	Prepare database using available data; Prepare GIS mapping; Convert current MPWMD divisions to GIS
October 2021	Official Census Data Received
November	Determine if boundary adjustments are minor or major. If major, Board considers forming a Redistricting Advisory Committee (RAC)
December - March	RAC meetings; Options determined; Public hearing for proposed ordinance to adopt plan; Public hearing for Board resolution to adopt.
May 12, 2022	Deadline for District to adopt
