CALIFORNIA AMERICAN WATER QUARTERLY WATER SUPPLY BUDGET: Jul – Sep 2020



Quarterly Water Budgets are developed in accordance with:

- SWRCB Orders 95-10, 98-04, 2002-02, and 2016-0016, Seaside Groundwater Basin Adjudication Decision, and District Rule 160 targets.
- Convene Low Flow Group and shift pumping away from Upper Valley Wells.
- ASR Plan − ASR recovery of 916 Acre Feet to occur over the fourth quarter of WY 2020.
- Pure Water Monterey Operations Have begun and the tracer test has been started. Operational Reserve is building.



CALIFORNIA AMERICAN WATER QUARTERLY WATER SUPPLY BUDGET: Jul - Sep 2020



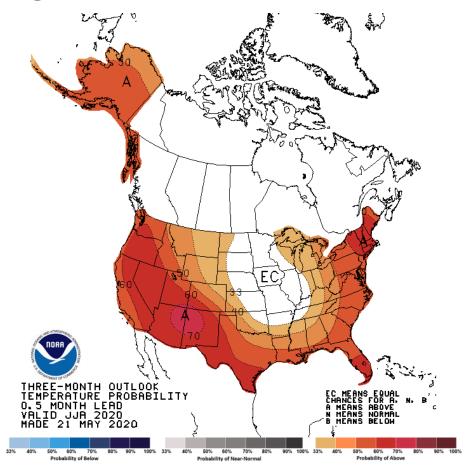
- Assumes full utilization of all Seaside Basin Costal Sub-Areas native groundwater during Water Year 2020.
- Assumes entering of Low Flow Season in late July and the Low Flow Group will begin to meet next month. Low Flow Group is the same membership as Quarterly Water Budget Group. Those members are MPWMD, CalAm, the California Department of Fish and Wildlife, the United States Fish and Wildlife Service the National Marine Fisheries Service, and the State Water Resources Board.
- Developed on June 4, 2020 by Quarterly Water Budget Group.
