

Public Hearing Item 11:

Consider Application for Variance from Separate Water Meter Requirement for a 40 Unit Senior Housing Project at 200 Glenwood Circle, Monterey (APN: 001-771-013)

Variance Request

- The Park Lane is a senior living facility requesting a variance to allow permanent submetering of 40 apartments
- MPWMD requires separate Water Meters for each unit
- During Cease & Desist Order (CDO) submeters can be used,
 but must be replaced with Cal-Am meters after moratorium
- Board may consider variance when Special Circumstances exist

Special Circumstances

- The Park Lane is currently served by 2 Cal-Am Master Meters
- The project will utilize a central hot water heating plant
 - Increases safety for elderly tenants (no gas in apartment)
 - Central system will eventually utilize solar (energy efficiency)
 - Area not needed for hot water heaters in apartments

Special Circumstances

- Permanent sub-meters are proposed
 - Senior housing project where all utilities are managed and paid for by The Park Lane
- Electronic in-unit sub-meters will be readable by the tenant
 - Measure (and monitor) both hot and cold water use
 - Accountability (Best Management Practice)
- Four previous Board approvals of permanent submetering in apartments with similar circumstances

Recommendation

Staff recommends the Board approve the variance and adopt the Findings of Approval with the following conditions:

- Electronic in-line meters recording hot and cold water consumption must be installed and maintained for each Dwelling Unit
- 2. Outdoor water use associated with new landscaping and common areas within the new building must be separately sub-metered
- 3. The applicant/owner shall provide the District with sub-meter consumption data upon request
- 4. Within one year, the applicant must obtain building permits (building permits are currently pending)
